I am renting my apartment/I own my own home. Do I qualify for this program? Yes, if...

Your apartment/home was built before 1978.

You have children under the age of 6 and they get a blood lead test before work begins.

You have children under the age of 6 who regularly spend time in your home (e.g., child care).

You meet the income guidelines to participate in the program. See chart at right.

Your landlord/or you are willing to participate under the requirements of the program.
